I'm not going to talk about the kind of *peace* the world gives, or the *peace* between men or that of nations. I'm going to tell you about pre-determined *Peace*. Pre-determined: by God himself; before the world was.

And there were in the same country shepherds abiding in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night. ... When the angel of the Lord came upon them, and proclaimed: I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to **all** people; for unto <u>vou</u> is born **this day** in the city of David a Savior, which is Christ the Lord. Lk. 2:8, 9, 10, 11. ... The hosts of heaven witnessed a physical manifestation of what God was doing: The Prince of *Peace* had come into the world; and in seeing it, could not contain themselves. The hosts of heaven broke out in Praise to God. And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly hosts praising God, and saying, Glory to God in the highest, and on earth *peace*, good will toward men. Lk.2:13, 14.

Once, the whole **world** was in a state of estrangement from its Creator; but when <u>Peace</u> came into the world, it thoroughly and completely changed the position of all men. When an individual's heart sees and trusts in the value of Christ's atoning death, he becomes reconciled to his Creator [God the Father].
