## PUTTING ON THE ARMOR OF GOD

The scriptures tell us: to know no man after the flesh. How can you do that? By putting on the whole armor of God.

In our text Eph.6:14. Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth and having on the breastplate of righteousness.

Having your loins girt about with truth is having a true commitment to the ONE in which, righteousness shall be the girdle of His loins, and faithfulness the girdle of His reins. Isa.59:17.

Wherefore, gird up the loins of your mind; be sober and hope to the end for the grace that is to be brought unto you at the revelation of Jesus Christ. I Pet.1:13.

And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace. Eph.6:15. How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of Him that bringeth good tidings, that publisheth peace; that bringeth good tidings of good that publisheth salvation; that saith unto Zion, Thy God Reigneth! Isa.52:7.

Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of

the wicked. **Eph.6:16.** For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith. **I John.5:4.** 

And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God: Eph.6:17.

But let us, who are of the day, be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love; and for an helmet, the hope of salvation. For God hath not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain salvation by our Lord Jesus Christ. I Thes.5:8&9.

Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints. **Eph.6:18**.

This Great Armor of God- covers and protects every part of our being.

The Father has given us **the Helmet of Salvation:** To put on our head. To protect our mind. It is our hope of salvation. ... We are being transformed by: the renewing of our mind... Rom.12:2.

**The Breastplate of Righteousness:** protects the heart of our inner man. And protects us from the flesh.

A Shield of Faith: That is able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. Not some ALL! I once thought prayer was my greatest weapon; but it's Faith above all. Above <u>all</u> taking the shield of Faith. Faith in Christ is what gives the power to our prayers.
